USE INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Pre-mix contents of each container before use to ensure the entire contents are uniform. Some separation may occur upon prolonged storage, which is soft and easily incorporated. **SOLAR COMPOUNDS** recommends mixing each component using a half-inch electric drill and Jiffy Mixing Blade for at least 3 to 5 minutes before use.
- 2) Measure out equal components of the product by weight or volume and mix thoroughly together until a uniform color is observed without streaks.

CURE SCHEDULE: Initial cure is achieved in 8-48 hours at room temperature. Final cure takes at least 7-10 days at 72°F. To accelerate the cure, higher temperatures can be used; 1 to 4 hours at 150°F is usually sufficient.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) This product has a tendency to separate upon storage and shipment; material should be mixed well prior to use. Store in a cool dry place.
- 2) Silicones can be poisoned by foreign contaminants like sulphur and amine compounds. Poisoning inhibits the cure of the silicone at the point of contact with the contaminant. Increasing the catalyst used, speeding up the cure time, or removing contaminants from the process can stop poisoning.
- 3) Supplied in 5-gallon and 55-gallon containers.
